Courses Taught

Trombone PMUS-1666-800 (Applied Trombone Lessons): Applied Music courses are designed to meet the requirements and desires of the students who wish to major in performance, to major in music with teacher certification or take applied music as an elective or minor, or to begin study in applied music to use as a teaching tool or as an area of enrichment where public performance is not the goal.

Emphasis is on attaining correctness and consistency of the basic fundamentals: Posture, Breathing, Embouchure, Tone, Flexibility, Range, Legato Articulation, Staccato Articulation, Intonation, Technique, Slide Technique, Multiple Tonguing, Jaw Vibrato, Tenor Clef, and Sight-Reading.

Trombone PMUS-2666-800 (Applied Trombone Lessons): Applied Music courses are designed to meet the requirements and desires of the students who wish to major in performance, to major in music with teacher certification or take applied music as an elective or minor, or to begin study in applied music to use as a teaching tool or as an area of enrichment where public performance is not the goal.

Emphasis at this level is on the application of correct fundamentals to a musical and communicative performance. The student will be encouraged to participate in small ensembles and to perform on student recital as well as in studio recitals. The daily routine will be tailored to meet the needs of the student with special emphasis on further development of basics such as range, technical proficiency, and the ability to read alto clef.

Students will study and become familiar with appropriate solo, etude, and pedagogical literature during their lessons. Sight-reading will be stressed and evaluated at each lesson. Students are expected to progress in their ability to sight-read during each semester.

Trombone PMUS-3666-800 (Applied Trombone Lessons): Applied Music courses are designed to meet the requirements and desires of the students who wish to major in performance, to major in music with teacher certification or take applied music as an elective or minor, or to begin study in applied music to use as a teaching tool or as an area of enrichment where public performance is not the goal.

Emphasis at this level is on artistic performance and consistency. Orchestral excerpts will be introduced and used as a means of learning the literature as well as developing the orchestral style. Interested students will study basics of jazz improvisation and cover the use of the slide vibrato. Additionally, students will be encouraged to learn to double on the euphonium, learning blowing basics and all fingerings. At this level, students should be securing positions in the top departmental ensembles and should be displaying leadership skills through their practice habits, academic accomplishments, and musical abilities. The performance major will concentrate on preparing a half junior recital during the second semester of this year.

Students will study and become familiar with appropriate solo, etude, and pedagogical literature during their lessons. Sight-reading will be stressed and evaluated at each lesson. Students are expected to progress in their ability to sight-read during each semester.

Students will study and become familiar with appropriate solo, etude, and pedagogical literature during their lessons. Sight-reading will be stressed and evaluated at each lesson. Students are expected to progress in their ability to sight-read during each semester.
