## OUTREACH & EVENTS

### **Living Library**

Living Library events are opportunities for people to engage with one another around stories in a supportive environment which encourages questions and open mindedness. "Books" -- people who are willing to share stories about their lives and diverse personal backgrounds -- and small groups of "Readers" engage in brave, in-depth, authentic conversations across gender, race, nationality, religion, and ability. Living Library events were held in Spring 2018, Spring 2019, and reimagined as an online dialogue in Spring 2020 due to the pandemic.

### **Transfer Student Outreach**

Based on research which indicated a need for community building and identified a gap in instruction & outreach to transfer students, I piloted outreach events including a scavenger hunt and Transfer Student Picnics to engage with this population.

### **InfoMotion**

InfoMotion, the Libraries' outreach tricycle was funded by a Libraries grant and, after custom design and fabrication, was launched in Summer 2017. As a vehicle for outreach and marketing, InfoMotion functions as a way for patrons to meet and interact with library employees where they are, outside of a physical library building. It is commonly used to welcome new students to campus and has been used for such special outreach as highlighting government information prior to the 2018 midterm elections.
