**ENVD 1030 Introduction to Landscape Architecture Studio**- Coordinated the freshman level landscape  
architecture studio  
(re-designed, taught and coordinated two semesters, 20 students, 200 students overall)

**LAND 3100 Intermediate Landscape Architecture Studio- Eco Urban Park Design** - Junior level landscape architecture studio within the new curriculum, this studio works closely with the City of Boulder to conceptualize a redesign of Violet Park in North Boulder  
(originated all course material, taught one semester, 17 students)

**LAND 3100 Intermediate Landscape Architecture Studio- Green Schoolyards: Playgrounds of the Future and Designing for Mental Health** - Junior level landscape architecture studio within the new curriculum, this studio worked closely with Boulder Valley School District to conceptualize a redesign of four elementary school schoolyards in Boulder  
(originated all course material, taught three semesters, 20 - 30 students)

**LAND 3100 Intermediate Landscape Architecture Studio- Interpretive Education as a Means of Eco-Healing** - Junior level landscape architecture studio within the new curriculum, this studio worked closely with Growing Up Boulder, City of Boulder Open Space Mountain Parks and Parks and Recreation to design interpretive education at trail heads associated with the Marshall Mesa Trail, responding to the Marshall Mesa Fire  
(originated all course material, taught one semester, 16 students)

**ENVD 3100 Interdisciplinary Studio Scale: Movement: Equity** - Interdisciplinary studio, this studio is working with the City of Boulder to develop innovative, human powered transportation elements and supporting infrastructure  
(co-originated all course material, taught one semester, 16 students)

**ENVD 3300 Praxis Studio- Portable Garden- Design + Build Studio** - Junior design-build studio covering interdisciplinary design principles, resulted in the design and build of a portable food growing system that is irrigated by an atmospheric water harvesting system installed in Denver Botanic Gardens  
(originated all course material, taught one semester, 15 students)

**ENVD 3300 Praxis Studio- Historic Site Engagement, Reimagining Interpretive Education- Design + Build Studio** - Junior design-build studio covering interdisciplinary design principles, resulted in three design-build projects addressing the challenges of reimagining historic interpretive education
