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## Librarianship - Selected Accomplishments

Librarianship is the equivalent of Teaching for other faculty and activities vary according to the specific librarian's role and responsibilities. My librarianship can be categorized into collaborative leadership, access and discovery services, and open access and accessibility initiatives.

### Collaborative Leadership

My collaborative leadership within the libraries is essential to growing the connections between our online platforms and the needs of those who use them. I am responsible for leading and participating in various organizational structures who want to improve the connection between researcher and resource.

- 2021/02-current, As Section lead of the Metadata Optimization and Discovery Section, I supervise three staff and one Teaching Professor. The section is responsible for metadata creation and cleaning, electronic resource access configuration, and other related jobs crucial for making library resources available and easy to find.
- 2018-current, As co-chair of the Collection Discovery, Access, and Reporting Group, and formally chair of the Electronic Resource Management Subgroup (2018-2020), I work with 10-12 libraries employees from Collection Development, Metadata, and other library teams to discuss issues around acquiring electronic resources, making resources discoverable and accessible, and deselecting and removing electronic resources.

### Access and Discovery Services

As Access and Discovery Librarian I am responsible for coordinating many of the activities that allow users to find library resources online. I suggest metadata improvements that can enhance item findability, configure platforms to connect to our resources, and evaluate access and discovery issues.

- 2019-current, Working with relevant stakeholders, led usability testing on LibGuides (2019), Summon and the Library Catalog (2020), EBSCO Discovery Services (2022), and VuFind (2023)
- 2019-current, Created Python programs to automate checking catalog and database access links (2019-), library database collections (2020-), and Internet Archive ebook status (2021-).
- 2018-current, Set up 11 Google Analytics accounts to track use of libraries' managed sites, conducted individual training for interested library employees on how to use Google Analytics.

## Open Access and Accessibility Initiatives

- 2018-current, As part of the development of a new open source library service provider FOLIO, I have joined the Resource Management Interest Group meetings (2018-2020) and the Electronic Resource Management Interest Group meetings (2022-current) to provide input on our librarian's and user's needs. FOLIO will be adopted by CU Boulder in 2023.
- 2019-current, Whenever possible I have configured our services to offer distinct links to Open Access resources using the Unpaywall database.
- 2018-current, I have worked closely with Libraries' Acquisitions and the CU Boulder Accessibility office on making our library electronic resource more accessible including; numerous updates to the library Accessibility webpage and coordinating 3 reports on our main discovery platforms with the Accessibility Lab.
